





The program will be presented at the Ken Theatre at 4061 Adams Avenue in San Diego, on alternate Thursday enenings as described below:

February 19, "THE GENERAL" Silent film with Buster Keaton and Marion Mack. William Pittenger's Civil War story of Andrew's Raiders' attempt to steal a Confederate locomotive. The most celebrated and active theatre organist, CHAUNCEY HAINES, will enliven the program with his original music.
